Last February 10th and 11th at the same time the festivity of Saint Apollonia was being celebrated, the 6th Bi-annual Congress of COEM and the Parallel 360-degree Hall were held in Madrid, Spain. In the latter, SEOP was represented by Prof. Ruth Mainé who talked about "Dentistry for babies".

SEOP also took part in the main halls of the 6th Bi-annual Congress of COEM with the presence of renowned speakers like Prof. Jorge Luis Castillo, President of The International Association of Pediatric Dentistry (IAPD), who delivered a lecture entitled "Early childhood caries: what does the scientific evidence tell us on disease management?" In this lecture, Prof. Castillo demonstrated his extensive knowledge on this clinical entity and implications regarding research on restorative and preventive solutions.
